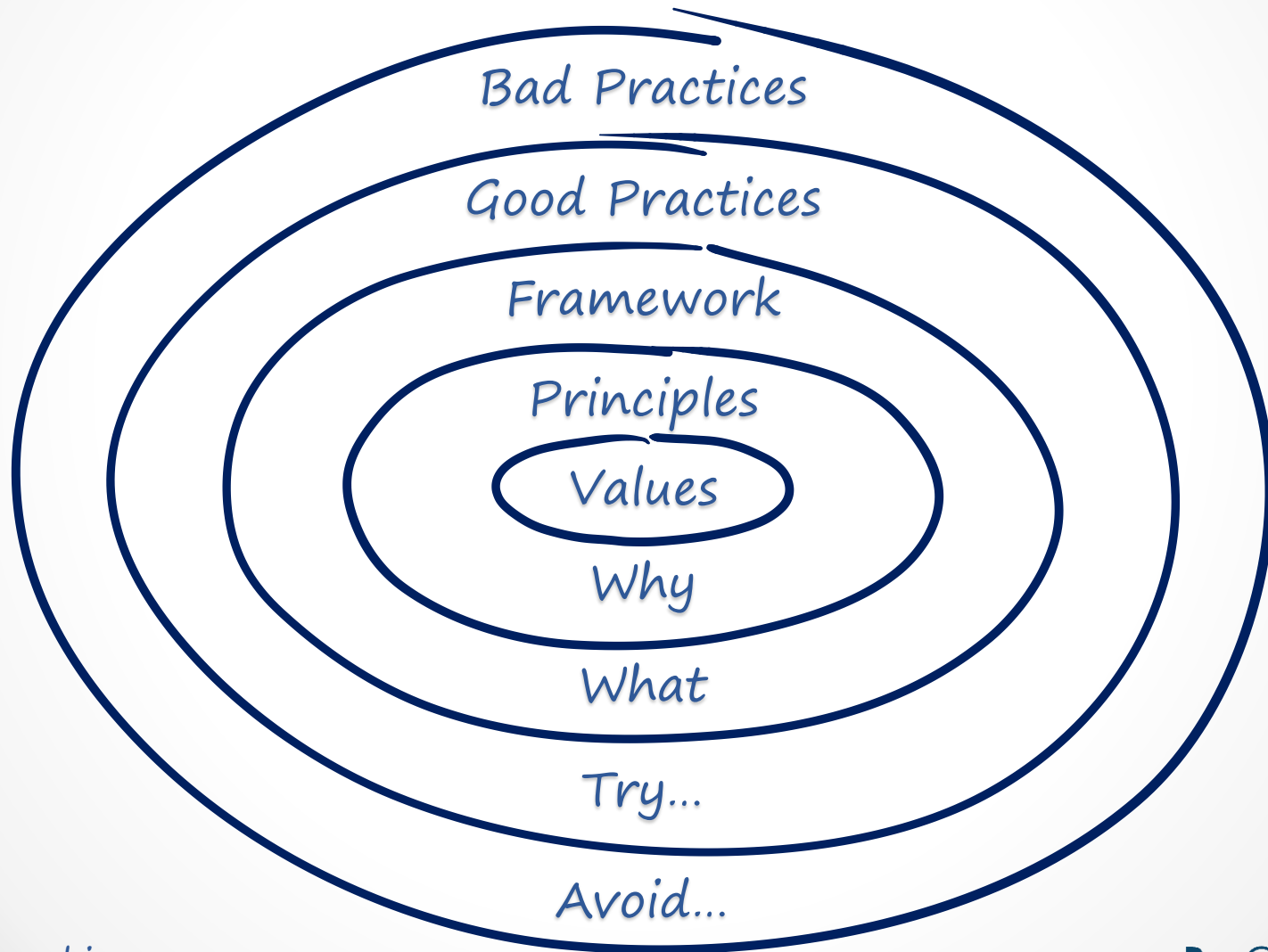

# Scrum is Agile

# Manifesto for Agile Software Development

We are uncovering better ways of developing software by doing it and helping others do it.  
Through this work we have come to value:

**Individuals and interactions** over processes and tools

**Working software** over comprehensive documentation

**Customer collaboration** over contract negotiation

**Responding to change** over following a plan

That is, while there is value in the items on the right, we value the items on the left more.

# Scrum Principles

(The way I see them today)

# 1. Increment

Deliver value every short cycle of month or less (Sprint).



## 2. Context

Your context matters, so build up your own process.

# 3. Transparency

Ensuring Transparency is  
cheaper than enforcing  
control.

## 4. Empiricism

*Inspect and Adapt frequently  
(every day and every Sprint)  
to head the right direction.*

# 5. Self-organization

Team knows how to do it, let  
the team decide.

## 6. Collaboration

Team is more than a sum of individuals.

# 7. Product Owner

One person deciding on direction helps in Optimizing Value.

## 8. Scrum Master

One person supporting the system makes everything go smoother

## 9. Focus

Limiting work in progress,  
setting time boxes for planned  
work and removing  
distractions let you focus.



# 10. Experiments

Every Sprint try something  
different.
